## CHINA'S CMEC ACCORD FOR 700 MW POWER PROJECTS



In an effort to overcome the growing demand of electricity, K-Electric signed a Joint Development Agreement (JDA) with China Machinery Engineering Corporation (CMEC) at the KE head office. China Machinery Engineering Corporation (CMEC) is one of the largest Engineering and

Constructions companies in China which specializes in the construction of power projects in the field of Generation, Transmission and Distribution. Also assisting on this project is China Datang Overseas Investment Company (CDTO), a Fortune 500 company.

The agreement is the first step in the establishment of two coal-fired power projects having a magnitude of 700 MW, which will boost KE's generation capacity with a total investment calculated at USD 1 Billion. This project furthers KE's vision to diversify its energy fuel-mix through cheaper sources, bridging the city's increasing electricity demand, offering low-cost tariff, while creating massive employment opportunities.

At this occasion Mr. Tayyab Tareen CEO stated, "This accord is in line with KE's vision of upholding Karachi as a net exporter of power in the years ahead. KE will greatly benefit from both CDTO and CMEC's expertise in coal power and [we] are ready to work at a very fast pace. The project will not only contribute to KE's fuel diversification strategy but take a significant step towards cheap base load power in Pakistan."

President of CDTO, Mr. Duan Zhong Min, speaking on this occasion, said, "We are fully committed to cooperate with KE and CMEC to successfully execute this Port Qasim project which shall go a long way in meeting the energy needs of the people of Pakistan."

Mr. Fang Yanshui, the Divisional Manager of CMEC added, "We at CMEC are strongly committed to devote ourselves towards

the social and economic development of Karachi by setting up a coal fired power plant in Port Qasim. We are extremely optimistic that this project will reach a speedy execution by having strong partners like KE and CDTO."

In a high-octane game, Khan Research Laboratories (KRL) held the champions K-Electric to a 1-1 draw. K-Electric topped the charts table with 48 points from 22 matches while Pakistan Army ended as the runners-up with 45 points with Pakistan Air Force (PAF) coming in third with 42 points. KE's striker, Muhammad Rasool was the tournament's top scorer with an incredible 23 goals and 3 hat tricks to his credit.

A special commendation for K-Electric by the FIFA President, Mr. Sepp Blatter, in a letter to PFF President, Makhdoom Syed Faisal Saleh Hayat which read, "Please pass on my own personal congratulations, along with those of the whole football family, to K-Electric on their performance. Its aim is to nurture a sense of ownership and responsibility towards the planet, and allowing conscientious citizens to share the opportunities and challenges of creating a sustainable world.

ISO Certified Operations are internationally recognized and regularly monitored for sustained high quality. A reputed team of lead Auditors visit each facility annually for a surveillance to mark improvement areas, further enabling entities in enhancing consumer services.

The lecture was the first of a series of lectures planned with the



### SMART TIPS TO SAVE ENERGY AND THE ENVIRONMENT

### ENVIRONMENT (CARE FOR YOUR ENVIRONMENT!)



- Take precautions while disposing of broken Energy Savers as they contain hazardous mercury.

   Use curtains, blinds, or shutters to stop heat from sunlight.
- Keep the AC Outdoor Unit under a shade as it enhances the cooling and efficiency of the AC.

- Replace conventional lights with LED LIGHTS (zero carbon foot print) and save 80% energy on sustainable basis.
- Use 23W SAVER which saves 75% energy instead of an incandescent bulb (which consumes 90% of energy to produce heat and 10% to light up your home).
- · Use maximum daylight whenever possible.
- Paint your home in LIGHT COLOURS as they reflect light and do not absorb heat.
